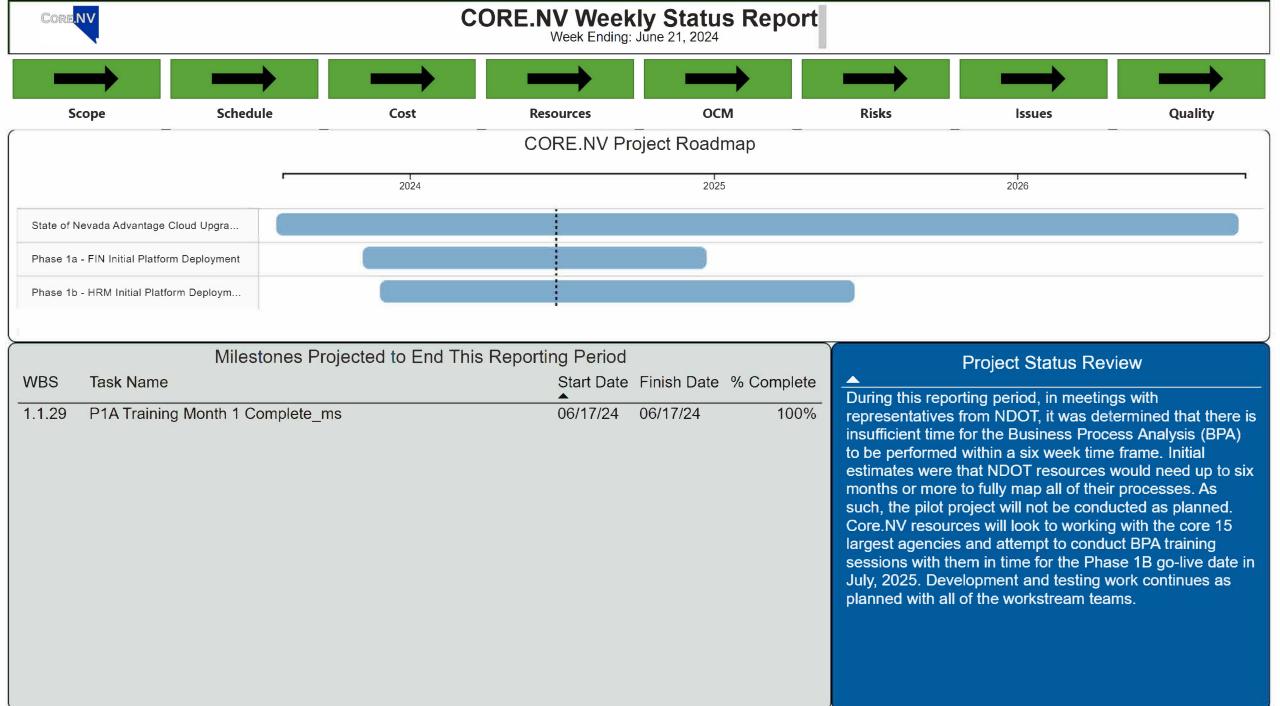

# **Workstream Status Review**

#### FIN

Here is the status report for FIN on the week ending 6/21/2004.

- 1) We completed the first week of IUAT Iteration 2. A large majority of user feedback was good and above for all items except user comfort level with the new system and 1 return of poor for overall impression of the new system. We will continue with IUAT next week.
- 2) The attempt to complete Business Process Mapping (BPM) of NDOT was halted due to lack of resources with NDOT. NDOT will continue the BPM and share results as they have them. This is all contained in Risk CORENV-2290 and our focus will now be on better training the end users on how to complete their work in ADV4.
- "Due to the fast timeline upon us, we cannot conduct as-is mapping for the entire state BPs. Rather, we decided to start with the Top 15 Spending Agencies and pilot this with NDOT. However, NDOT cannot support the timeline in which OCM needs the output to understand what their impacts really are for Phase 1A. NDOT believes they can list all the processes against MVP P1A and then map them into a template, but it will take up to 6 months. OCM cannot support this timeline in order to prepare and support the OCM Change Readiness activities needed before Go-Live. If and when NDOT does provide this information, it will be handed off to the FIN team. DHHS has also committed to providing their BPs against MVP P1A by July 15th. If and when this information is provided, it will be sent to the FIN team as well. OCM has a plan to survey the Top 15 Spending Agencies in July to attempt to pull detailed change impacts and as-is operational info to use for Phase 1A Change Readiness activities. OCM will then send any relevant change impacts learned from the survey to the FIN team."
- 3) We started looking at ways to better communicate with NDOT in regards to decisions and processes. While we have a very engaged group of NDOT SMEs, the other interested parties who have not been attending meetings or are new to their roles have been requesting demonstrations, clarifications, or questioning decisions which have already been made. While we understand the difficulty in catching up to the project for new interested persons and wish to be helpful in these requests, the FIN Team does not have the resources to be pulled off of upcoming project objectives for answering these questions and requests. We will continue to work with OCM to work on a communications solution and will also encourage individuals who have questions to rely on their SMEs and NDOT Leadership. This should relieve some of the pressure of the project teams and Leadership will have a direct line to CORE.NV Leadership for questions or requests which are not able to be handled by the NDOT SMEs.

#### HRM

HRM began IUAT this week, with testing being performed on Thursday, 6/20 and Friday, 6/21.

- Testing was modified to reduce the time spent by testers, due to a reduced load in scripts
- Some business processes in HRM are waiting to be decided, leading to less scripts to being needed to test
- The HRM testing team has reported that testing has gone well the first sessions

HRM is wrapping up Sprint 3.2 and preparing for 3.3

- 5. SharePoint Updates: New General FAQ Page developed, awaiting approval to publish, targeted next week.
- 6. CORE.NV Monthly Newsletter: Scope and template in development.
- 7. Metrics: Project metric input and OCM metrics development in progress, Implement in July.
